

The Performance Dictionary
The High Kick

graduation, short: the same as graduation kicks except the working leg *alternates*; the right toes touch the floor, the left leg kicks waist, and the right leg performs a high kick

graduation, short fan: perform short graduation kicks to the *diagonal* and add a fan kick to the front

grapevine kicks: step to the side 1; step cross under 2; step to the side 3; close in parallel first 4; jump kick right 56 and recover in parallel first 78

grapevine, turn kicks: the same as the grapevine above except perform a turn on 3 instead of stepping to the side, and before the jump kick

Kilgore: **straight jump kicks with a prep performed between kicks* the right leg kicks to the right side 12 and to the front 34, the left leg kicks front 56, the right leg kicks to the right side 78 and closes on 12

piano kicks: **a prep is performed between each kick* prep on 1 and perform a right eye high kick on 2; while descending the right leg crosses over the left and touches the toe to the ground in front of the left foot on 3; kick the right leg to eye high on 4, then lower to the original prep position on 5 and repeat to the other side

Rockette fan series: facing the right diagonal, straight jump kick right 12 and left 34; next, perform a right inside fan kick moving to the left diagonal 56; last, follow through from the fan by bringing the right leg into a hook on 7, then kick eye high on 8; and repeat to the other side
